Starting from Namma Bengaluru to Kai Chala to Kem Cho and Padharo Maro Desh and then Sastriyakaal we tend to see different landscapes different flavors of food, dress and culture which India is known for.

RTH is not just a road trip, it's a story of different states and culture which you go through on this journey. We ensure you have a lifetime experience like never before.

Starting from Idli Sambar, Mishal Pav, world's tallest Statue of Unity, Fafda, Dhokla, Lake City, Daal Baati Churma, Pink City, Ghewar, Punjab ke Khet-Khalihan, lassi, Chole Kulche, World's greatest Himalayas, High passes and Peaks, Green Valleys, Deserts, Rivers, Waterfalls, tough terrains, Kharudung-La, Pangong Lake, Last Villagee of India, Kasmir ki waadiyan, War Memorials, LOC, Golden temple, National parks ,Taj Mahal, Vrindavan, Temples, Forts and many more to make the journey most adventurous, unforgettable & breathless.

## DETAILED ITINERARY

**Day 01.(28<sup>st</sup> April):-** Bengaluru to Pune, Distance : 850 Kms, Grand Flag from Bangalore time: 5:30AM

We flag off our convoy from Bengaluru from a common meet up point and proceed towards Pune.

**Day 02 (29<sup>th</sup> April):-** Pune to Kevadia,, Distance :- 550 Kms

Here we visit The Statue of Unity is the world's tallest statue at 182 metres (597 ft). It rises 54 metres (177 ft) higher than the previous record holder, the Spring Temple Buddha in China's Henan province. The previous tallest statue in India was the 41 m (135 ft) tall statue of Lord Hanuman at the Paritala Anjaneya Temple near Vijayawada in the state of Andhra Pradesh. The monument is constructed on a river island named Sadhu Bet, 3.2 km away from and facing the Narmada Dam downstream. The statue and its surroundings occupy more than 2 hectares, and are surrounded by a 12 km long artificial lake formed by the Garudeshwar weir downstream on the Narmada river.

**Day 03 (30<sup>th</sup> April):-** Kevadia to Jaipur, Distance : 800 Kms

Here we start our journey towards Jaipur while we explore possible places on the way, lunch at Udaipur, Udaipur lake, Sajjangadh Fort and reach our hotel. A drive of different terrains and culture which gives you an experience of diversities India has across the nation. The day is long and has a lot of drive. Upon reaching the destination have dinner and rest.

**Day 04 (01<sup>st</sup> May):-** Jaipur to Chandigarh/Mohali, Distance : 475 Kms

Here we start our journey towards Chandigarh. Post Breakfast on the way we will go to Hawa Mahal and Jal Maha in Jaipur. Upon reaching the destination if time permits we can visit Mansa Devi Temple post which we can have dinner and rest for the day.

**Day 05 (02<sup>nd</sup> May) :-** Chandigarh/Mohali to Kullu, Distance : 310 Kms

Today the drive is scenic and adventurous as we start our journey towards Manali. A drive of different terrains and ghats which will be a small test of your patience while we drive through scenic hills. Upon reaching the destination have dinner and rest for the day.

**Day 06 (03<sup>rd</sup> May) :-** Kullu/Manali

A day to relax and explore Kullu & Manali. Do activities like Paragliding, Rafting and spend sometime in the famous River side Café in the evening. Also a day to get your cars checked before the most adventurous drive starts to Leh.

**Post dinner will keep special Himachali cultural show and post that a small briefing would be done and the organisers would explain the rules and guidelines. Get a good sleep before the next big day.**

**Day 07 (04<sup>th</sup> May) :-** Kullu to Jispa, Distance: 135 Kms

Today we start our journey to Leh Stopping at Jispa for a night. Today we cross Atal Tunnel (World's longest tunnel above 10000 ft., Keylong (3350m).

### **Day 08 (05<sup>th</sup> May) :- Jispa to Leh, Distance : 330 Kms**

Leave for Leh by early morning, through Baralacha, Zing Zing Bar, Gata Loops, Nakeela and Lachangla Pass 16,617 ft. Lunch at Pang. After Lunch drive to Leh passing through Skyangchu Thang (Biggest and Highest Plateau on Earth on Stretch of 42 Kms), Tanlang La Pass 17,5856ft(2nd highest motorable road in the world) and Indus Valley. Upon arrival in Leh you'll be met by our representative and check in at our Hotel. Overnight in hotel.

### **Day 09 (06<sup>th</sup> May) :- Leh Explore**

A day to relax in Leh and acclimatize yourself. After breakfast drive to explore the beauty of Shanti Stupa, Leh palace, Thiksey Monastery and market. Shanti Stupa:- Shanti stupa was founded in 1985 sponsored by Japanese for world peace. It was inaugurated by His holiness the 14th Dalai lama. Shanti stupa has a spectacular view of Leh city and Stok glacier.

Leh Palace:-The Leh Palace known as 'Lachen Palkhar' was built by Singay Namgyal, around the beginning of 17th century AD. The nine-storey Palace is now deserted, and archeological survey of India has taken up the renovation work. Overnight in hotel.

Visit The Hall of Fame and if you wish to see the lights show in the evening you're free to stay back and see the show. A place that shows how Indian Army fought with its Martyrs and Arms used during the Indo-Pak war. It also has a small souvenir store

### **DAY 10 (07<sup>TH</sup> May) :-** Leh To Nubra Valley Via Khardung La Pass 17,582 FT., Distance: 120 Kms

After breakfast, we drive to Nubra valley. The journey from Leh to Nubra spans 39 km and passes through the iconic Khardung La Pass. At an altitude of 17,582 ft., it is one of the five highest motorable roads in the world. Shrouded in a blanket of snow, the pass affords you sweeping views of the Indus Valley, along with the seemingly endless Zaskar range in the south. To your north, behold the magnificent Saser massif in all its glory.

Adorned with fluttering prayer flags, Khardung La top is arguably the most picturesque location in Ladakh. From Khardung La, we continue the journey to Nubra valley, also known as Ldumra or the Valley of Flowers. Sitting at an altitude of approximately 10,000 ft., it is nestled in the north of Ladakh, right between the Ladakh Himalayas and the Karakoram range. Once at Nubra, we check into our camps/hotel in Hunder for the night. Take in the breathtaking views of the lush oasis villages set as a stark contrast amidst barren mountains. These villages give you a rare glimpse into the fascinating lives of the locals. Overnight stay at the camp/hotel.

### **Day 11 (08<sup>th</sup> May) :-** Nubra to Turtuk to Nubra, Distance: 250 kms

After an early breakfast, we head out from the camp/hotel, and drive to Turtuk Via Shyok War memorial, Turtuk is a village in the Indian union territory of Ladakh and the headquarters of an eponymous community development block. Turtuk is one of the northernmost villages of India, second only to Murgo Village, the northernmost village of India. Also known as the last village of India.

### **Day 12 (09<sup>th</sup> May) :** Nubra to Pangong Tso, Distance: 240 kms

Reigning at an altitude of 13,930 ft., the alpine lake of Pangong spans about 5 - 8 km in width and 140 km in length, sharing territory with India (30%) and China (70%). Catch the slanting rays of the sun on the bright, crystal-clear waters of the lake, which also bears beautiful reflections of the barren hills that guard it. Throughout the day, catch the shuttle change in the colors of the lake - from clear blue to dark green to turquoise and more. The entire setting could not be more perfect. Overnight stay at the hotel.

**DAY 13 (10<sup>th</sup> May) :- Pangong Tso To Leh Via Chang La Pass, Distance: 225 Kms**

After an early breakfast, we drive back to Leh via Chang La Pass, another one of the world's highest motorable roads (17,586 ft.) A scenic 8 hours drive brings you to the top of Chang La Pass, a perfect spot for photography. From Chang La Pass, we head down to Leh.

**Day 14 (11<sup>th</sup> May) :- Leh to Kargil Via Magnetic Hills, Distance: 220 Kms**

Post breakfast we check out from the hotel and proceed towards Kargil. On the way we explore Magnetic hills, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, Lamayuru (the Invisible Village), Fotu La Pass, Namika La Pass. Visit Drass Kargil War memorial. Reach the hotel and rest post dinner.

**Day 15 (12<sup>th</sup> May) :- Kargil to Srinagar Via Zozi la Pass, Distance: 210 Kms**

After an early breakfast, we drive to Srinagar via Zojila Pass, Zero Point Sonmarg. A scenic 6 hours drive brings you to the beautiful city of Srinagar. After experiencing Shikara Ride in Dal check in to the hotel and enjoy the day.

**Day 16 (13<sup>th</sup> May) :- Srinagar to Amritsar, Distance: 440 Kms**

After an early breakfast, check-out from houseboats and proceed towards Amritsar. On the way visit to the famous Jwala Devi temple. Also witness Chenab river and if time permits we could also go to Naag Mandir. Reach Amritsar and rest post check-in.

**Day 17 (14<sup>th</sup> May) :- Amritsar Explore**

Wake up and post breakfast visit Golden temple, Jalianwala Bagh, Gobindgarh fort, Durgiana Temple and Wagah Border. Post The Beating Retreat Ceremony we headback towards market. Explore the city life and post dinner rest.

**DAY 18 (15<sup>th</sup> May) :- Amritsar To Vrindavan, Distance: 600 Kms**

After an early breakfast, check-out from hotel and proceed towards Vrindavan. On the way see Jalandhar, Ludhiana. Reach Vrindavan and rest post check-in.

**Day 19 (16<sup>th</sup> May) :- Vrindavan to Gwalior, Distance: 182 Kms**

After an early breakfast, check-out from hotel and proceed towards Taj Mahal. Post Taj Mahal take the highway to Gwalior via Chambal Ghaati. Upon reaching visit Gwalior fort, Scindia Palace. Check-In and rest post dinner.

**Day 20 (17<sup>th</sup> May) :- Gwalior to Nagpur, Distance: 700 Kms**

After an early breakfast, check-out from hotel and proceed towards Nagpur. A long journey back home via Jhansi. Reach Nagpur and rest post check-in.

**Day 21 (18<sup>th</sup> May) :- Nagpur to Hyderabad, Distance: 500 Kms**

After an early breakfast, check-out from hotel and proceed towards Hyderabad. Reach Hyderabad and rest post check-in.

**Day 22 (19<sup>th</sup> May) :- Hyderabad to Bengaluru, Distance: 550 Kms**

After an early breakfast, check-out from hotel and proceed towards Bengaluru. Reach Bengaluru and a small meet at NH7 for a quick chai break. The trip ends here and we hope that you have taken a lot of memories back home with this Roadtrip.
